

AIRPORT CHARGES

LANDING FEES

Single payment is a payment for 1 landing on LKPO (related to concrete and grass-strip). Payments are divided by type and weight of aircraft.

Type of aircraft according to weight	Landing fee
ULL – ultralight aircraft	2 EUR or 50 CZK
Heavy aircraft up to 1 ton	3 EUR or 70 CZK
Heavy aircraft up to 2 tons	6 EUR or 150 CZK
Heavy aircraft over 2 tons	4 EUR or 100 CZK for every initiated ton

PARKING FEES

A parking fee calculated on the maximum take-off weight (MTOW) is levied for aircraft parking.

	Parking fee
APRON parking – MTOW up to 2t	The first 2 hours are free 0700 -1900: 0,4 EUR or 8 CZK/hour 1900 - 0700:0,15 EUR or 4 CZK/hour
APRON parking – MTOW over 2t	The first 2 hours are free 0700 -1900: 0,5 EUR or 12 CZK/hour 1900 - 0700:0,25 EUR or 6 CZK/hour
Parking area – MTOW up to 2t	4 EUR or 100 CZK per day
Parking area– MTOW over 2t	8 EUR or 200 CZK per day
Parking in a hangar - do MTOW 2t	10 EUR or 250 CZK per day
Parking an aircraft in a hangar - MTOW over 2t	16 EUR or 400 CZK per day

Prices for parking areas mentioned above are valid only for parking three days maximum. Price for long-term parking will be set based on a contract deal.

OTHER FEES

National flight – fee for passenger in commercial traffic	3 EUR or 80 CZK/passenger
International flight - fee for customs and passport clearance of crews and passengers of flights outside EU and Schenghen zone	4 EUR or 100 CZK/person
International flight – fee for security clearance of crews and passengers	8 EUR or 200 CZK/person
Airside driving permit (own car)	8 EUR or 200 CZK
Take-off or landing outside the aerodrome regular operational hours	SUN, SAT, HOL 19 EUR or 500 CZK/hour MON-FRI 12 EUR or 300 CZK/hour
Other services	5 EUR or 120 CZK

EXEMPTIONS AND DEROGATIONS FROM CHARGES:

Flights of the following aircraft are not subject to charges:

- flights of aircraft registered in a Military aircraft register operated by Armed Forces of the Czech Republic.
- flights performed exclusively for the transport, on official mission, Heads of State, Heads of Government, and Government Ministers;
- search and rescue flights authorised by a relevant RCC body;
- Civil Aviation Authority flights;
- flights performed exclusively for the purpose of checking or testing equipment used or intended to be used as ground aids to air navigation, excluding positioning flights by the aircraft concerned;
- aircraft carrying out flights of air rescue services inclusive of secondary and repatriation flights and flights directly connected with human life rescue;
